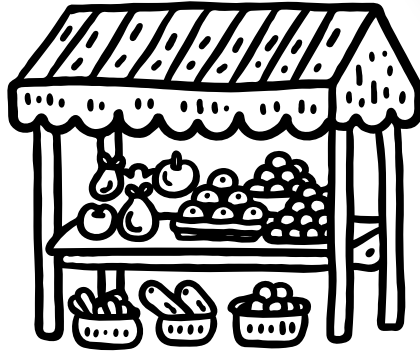

Capacity: 100 men and 10 women.

Length of Stay: Varies based on client's needs.

Services: Advocacy; counseling; 3 meals/day; clothing; Spanish; handicapped accessible; nurse; doctor visits 2 times a week; day programs; limited transportation services; limited storage; showers available for females.

Restrictions: Must be over the age of 18.

Referral: Must be referred by the Common Ground Resource Center (Common Ground's contact number is 508-620-2690) at SMOC (located at 90 Lincoln St. Framingham, MA 01702).

Restrictions: Sobriety; must manage own supply of medication; 10 pm curfew.

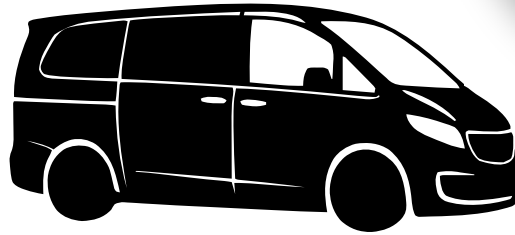
